## Principal's Report: Mr. Raimo

• Welcome to all new families; we are committed to doing our best for your children and to partner with you

- Our school theme this year is Sicomac Eagles SOAR:
  - S Self regulation
  - O On task
  - A Acting responsibly
  - R Respect
- We are a responsive classroom school which means we embrace challenging academics while also empowering students to work hard and make intentional choices
- We have morning meetings set in our daily schedule which provide a calm moment to connect before starting the school day
- Constraints are hard for kids and school is filled with constraints, so we make sure to go outside, take nature walks and let the kids be kids
- Both at home and school, we should be setting expectations and parameters, working on manners, holding the kids accountable, and sharing our values
- New Staff Member:
  - The district has hired a a team of special law enforcement officers (SLEO III) to provide security during the academic school day
  - Sicomac is so grateful to have Officer Rob, a police officer in Wayne for 25 years
  - He is armed, will have his squad car visibly parked in front of the school, and checks the school inside and outside throughout the day
- · Never prop open a door always get buzzed in by the front office
- · Parking lot update:
  - The barricade goes up at 3pm, please do not enter the parking lot if the barricade is up
  - The parking lot will reopen after Kindergarten is dismissed
  - Do not let kids run through the lot meet your children at the top of the school or on the sidewalks
- Safety Patrol just held it's first meeting and consists of our 5th graders
- Front lobby update:
  - The sign in process has become more secure; please always bring your license to sign in
- Promethean Panels are being installed on September 14 and the whole building is now complete with these powerful tools for learning
- Now that Picture Day is over, please check your email for communication from the photographer

- Sicomac holds 2 emergency drills every month:
