- It's his 20th year in education from science teacher to supervisor to AP to Principal
- EMS received the Schools to Watch award less than 20 schools in NJ receive it
- Pro tip: EMS drop off is 7:45-8am; try to get there by 7:50am because of traffic
- We speak with all 5th grade students and they visit EMS in order to get comfortable
- Getting involved in clubs and activities are a great way to make friends; all clubs are student run; if your child thinks of a club and finds an advisor they can run it
- We help navigate social situations and conflicts with our fantastic guidance team
- Students will receive letter grades and we offer personalized academic support
- Attendance policy no more than 10% absences (18 days); only approved absences are Take Your Child to Work Day and religious observances
- Pickup is 2:56pm
- TIE Time is 30 minutes where students get enrichment or intervention for extra support; students can see teachers for help or go to music, art, etc.
- Phones: must remain in locker all day and cannot be checked during lunch
- Social media is a big responsibility for a 6th grader and they need guidance
- EMS provides ChromeBooks to all students
- Lockers are stressful! We suggest getting a combination lock and practicing at home
- Question: Is there a date where students are able to tour the building and get laptops:
  - Dates will be coming very soon; in late August there is a scavenger hunt
  - Laptop handout happens in homerooms first day
- Question: How does lunch work:
  - Grades eat together at the same time and have a snack at TIE time
